Town of Superior goes solar

SUPERIOR - Standard Renewable Energy recently completed solar installations on several town of Superior facilities including the Town Hall, Parks & Recreation building, Coal Creek Fire Station and the North and South pools.

These systems will generate 56,524 kilowatt-hours of renewable energy and offset more than 109,000 pounds of carbon emissions yearly. The town of Superior spent \$96,925 to install the photovoltaic systems.

The town of Superior reviewed proposals from several renewable energy companies and chose Houston-based Standard Renewable, which has offices in Boulder and Denver, because it provided the most comprehensive proposal including system efficiency and generation, cost, project completion and financing.

The town is planning on installing similar systems at its water treatment facilities.
